*Amazing blend of Montepulciano, Aglianico, Primitivo, Cabernet & Merlot. What a complex show this one is. Tons of layers with every varietal stepping to the stage. The Aglianico and Primitivo bring the spice while the Merlot gives an amazing mid palate. The Cab provides the back bone for great structure. Awesome!!!

2007 Monte Zovo Amarone

Veneto, Italy DOC

*This is a full bodied wine of classic varietals Corvina Veronese, Rondinella & Molinara. Ripe plum, almond and cherry kick this wine into high gear and place it in a constant state of evolution. The beauty is, that this wine will taste different tomorrow than it does today. So, even if you've tried it already, give it another go. You'll get something new every time!

2006 Stefano Accordini Acinatico Amarone Classico

Veneto, Italy DOC

*Situated in the heart of the hilly region of Negrar, this wine has great acidity and tannin with hints of almond and dark berries. As with most Amarone, these grapes are dried until the end of February before vinification.

2004 Tenuta Carretta 'Garassino' Barbaresco

Piedmont, Italy DOCG

*More often than not, Barbaresco seems to come off as the more feminine side of Piedmont than her Barolo counterpart. Decant this sweetheart & wait as long as you can stand it. Ripe fruit, chocolate and soft, complex tannins (with fantastic structure & personality) induce yens for red meat & mature cheeses to hit the table. Stellar vintage...only a bit left in the province!

2004 Tenuta Carretta 'Cascina Ferrero' Barolo

Piedmont, Italy DOCG

*Known as the 'Wine of Kings', Barolo is so layered that it'll take ya 10 minutes just to get over the first taste. 100% Nebbiolo & chalk full of phenomenal nuances of wild berries, cocoa & spice. Again, decant this juice when you sit down & prepare yourself for a robust and complex vintage by the time your mains arrive...2004 was a dynamite year!! You have to pair this big boy up with either our Tenderloin or New York.

*The waiting is over...2008 has finally been released! No doubt, Schug puts out one of our favorite Pinots from the New World. Bright notes of red fruit and new oak spice match this Pinot up with our Stuffed Chicken and Atlantic Salmon like serendipitous magic.

2008 Francis Coppola Merlot 'Blue Label'

California, USA

*Winemaker Corey Beck has taken fruit (Merlot, Petite Sirah, Syrah and Petit Verdot) from Napa, Sonoma & Monterey and blended a beautiful balance of aromatics and acidity. Fantastic with our Pastas & stuffed Chicken Breast.

2006 Châteaux du Trignon Gigondas

Rhône Valley, France AC

*You don't even need to get your nose in this glass to catch the aromas of red currant, olive & truffle...they're profound. Winemaker Florence Quiot has blended Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre and Cinsault perfectly to give us dynamite balance & phenomenal length.
